A postdoctoral research fellow position is available at the Food Science and Technology Programme in the Department of Chemistry, National University of Singapore. The research project is to develop a novel technology to control fungal spoilage of fruits using light-emitting diodes. The candidate should possess a PhD degree in area of food science or closely related fields with research experience and knowledge in microbiology and molecular biology. Demonstrated experience with fungal spoilage is highly desirable. This position will also require training graduate and undergraduate students. The candidate should have good verbal and written communication skills, and should be prepared for independent research activities, writing papers and scientific reports. The position is a 1-year term, renewable for up to 3 years depending on progress. The starting date will be January 1st, 2017.
